PROCESS OF ADMISSION & TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Play Group :

Rolling Admission after Registration : Children barely out of their infancy at the two and half+age are granted admission to play group freedom is provided to do anything they wish without any restriction. They pick up some oral and stroke making skill through rhymes, stories and play way activities.

Kindergarten (Lower and Upper):

Since the aim of this school is to build a strong foundation, children are admitted to two years of kindergarten. Lower at three and half + age the fundamentals such as learning values like patience, co-operation and responsibilities and opening up to senses to differentiate colours, shapes, size and upper at four and half + age self-study is fostered through a slightly more formalized pattern of text book & note books and through teacher-student interaction.

Class 1st to Xth:

Admission granted after registration & qualifying the entrance test subject teacher each their own specialities and a lot of emphasis is given to creative subjects literary & cultural activities and value based research work, with an aim to develop an understanding concepts of the various subject offered.

ADMISSION DETAILS

1. Children are admitted to the school the age of two and half +.
2. Child's name may be registered in advance in the year in which admission is sought registration form is available at the school office.
3. The registration fee is Rs. 250/- per child. Registration done for a particular year is not transferable to another year. Fresh registration is necessary if the child is required to be considered for an other year. Payment of registration fee does not mean guarantee of admission in the school.
4. Admission are granted after a written test and a personal interview with the child and also the parents.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS



1. Original Birth Certificate issued by the Municipal Corporation for admission from Nursery to Std. 1st.
2. For admission to Std. 2nd onwards school leaving certificate and report card of previous school is essential.
3. Four Passport size photograph.
 - Admission of a child to a school will be treated as a acceptance of all school rules (as in forced or amended from time to time) by the parents / guardians. Rules are subjected to change at the direction of the school management.
 - Name and date of birth as recorded in the previous school leaving certificate will be, considered final. Parents / Guardians must ensure that these entries are corrected to avoid any problem later.
 - Right to admission is reserved.

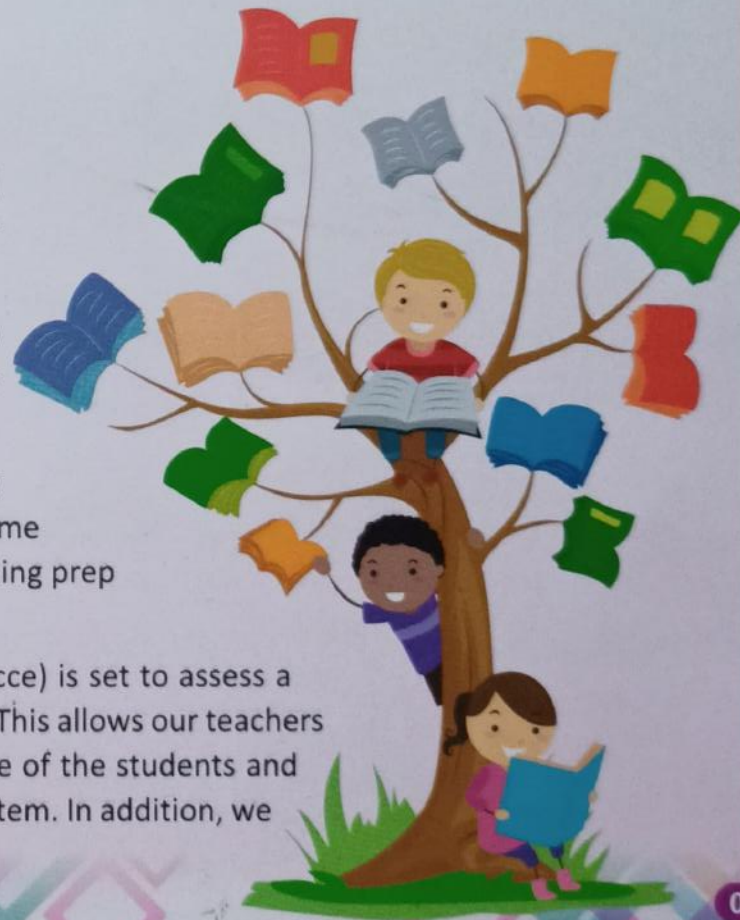
SCHOOL ASSESSMENT

Our students are regularly assessed so as to monitor the progress of the class as a whole and that of the individual student. This allows us to target those students with specific needs or difficulties and to provide them with remedial help as and when ever required.

Our teachers willingly provide extra classes to those with academic need. Our aim is to ensure that each student has the support required to fulfill his academic Potential and that such help should be provided before the student realizes that he is in difficulty.

A clearly Planned day allows curriculum time for each subject with teachers Providing detailed notes and guidance in the classroom. The day also allows each student adequate time for self-study and individual work outside the classroom both through an organized evening prep and through quiet times when work can be pursued on a more voluntary basis.

Throughout the year the newly introduced continuous and comprehensive evaluation (cce) is set to assess a student's progress in each module studied in every subject through a variety of activities. This allows our teachers to administer tests and evaluation through formative assessment in multiple intelligence of the students and encourage their strengths and supplement areas of concern with appropriate support system. In addition, we organize a formal set of examinations each term.

SCHOOL FEE SCHEDULE

Fee for all classes will be charged for 12 months and the same will be realized in 8 months.

- Fee Deposited by cash in school Account office from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on all working days.

TERM AND CONDITIONS :

- All the due fee to be deposited before every term examination.
- The fees may be Deposited before date of month 10th.
- Late Payment fine Rs. 50/- after the due date 15th of every month. Next months Rs. 100/-.
- Bus charges are payable for 12 months. (in three time payable)
- School Transport Facility if once availed, can not be discontinued without two months prior notice or two months fee in lieu of notice will be charged.
- Fee collection schedule is subject to change without prior notice

NOTE : THE NAME WOULD BE STRUCK OFF AND RE-ADMISSION FEE WOULD BE CHARGED.

WITHDRAWALS

If a child, who is newly admitted into the school, is withdrawn before the beginning of the academic session, 50% of admission fee & will be feted as admission processing fees charge after the beginning of the academic session.

In case a child is withdrawal after the commitment of the academic session he/she will have to pay the full fee for the rest of the academic year before a transfer certificate is issued. Notice of withdrawal must be given in written at least a month in advance.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE : Transfer Certificate (T.C.) will be issued by the principal. The application for Transfer Certificate must be accompanied by a transfer fee of Rs. 250/-.

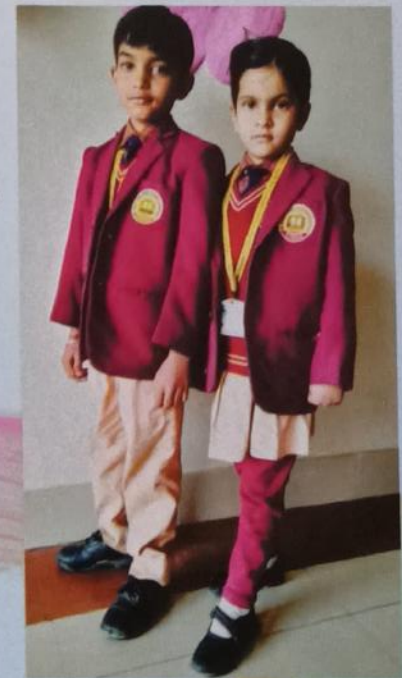

Face Towel is compulsory for all students

SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- A Student must carry his School Diary to school everyday. It must have his/hir photograph, with identity information complete and signed by parents.
- Students who come to school by their own transport should reach at school before the bell rings.
- Students should be neatly dressed. The school uniform is to be worn on every working day. Students who are sloppily dressed or not in uniform will be severely dealt with.
- Non Sikh Boys should get their hair cut at regular intervals.
- Girls should plait their hair if it is below the shoulders. Short hair should be neatly cut and pinned.
- Students are expected to respect the property of others. This includes respect for school property. No student should damage any school furniture, write or draw any thing on walls, furniture or in any way damage things belonging to others. Damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the Class Teacher or to the Principal. Any damage done will be made good by the one who causes it.
- The School is not responsible for goods lost. It is advisable not to bring valuable articles (like Watches or Cell Phones, I-Pods, Cameras etc.) to school.
- Students are not allowed to wear any jewellery to school (No Chains, Rings, Bangles, Bracelets). Girls may wear one pair of small ear rings or studs only.
- Students who come to school in the care of servants should never leave before the servant arrives. In case of delay, they should report to the school office. Those who go home alone should be prompt in returning straight home.
- Students should be polite wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their conduct. They should greet their teachers when they meet them. Bullying and use of foul language is a punishable offence.
- The school reserves the right to suspend or to take strict disciplinary action against a student whose diligence or progress in studies is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.
- Parents and Guardians may not visit their wards or Teachers in the classrooms without the permission of the Principal.
- As far as possible, once a child has come to school, he/she should not be asked to come home on half day leave or leave from any period, unless it is an emergency.

- R.P.C.S. provides education from Nursery to Class X. Therefore it is expected that juniors should be treated with love and affection, while the Juniors show all respect to their seniors.
- No students shall indulge in any of the following practices namely.
 - (1) Spitting in or near the school building.
 - (2) Disfiguring or otherwise damaging any school property.
 - (3) Smoking.
 - (4) Any form of Gambling.
 - (5) Rowdism and Rude behaviour.
 - (6) Use of Violence in any form.
 - (7) Casteism or communalism.
- The observance of rules of discipline of the school and good behaviour is an essential condition to a student's continuance in the school. In case a student violates the school rules or indulges in any form of indiscipline, strict action like expulsion/suspension/rustication shall be taken against the students.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular Activities (CCAs) earlier known as Extracurricular Activities (ECA) are the components of Non-Academic Curriculum helps to develop various facets of the personality development of the child and students. For all-round development of the child, there is a need of Emotional, Physical, Spiritual and Moral Development that is complemented and supplemented by Co-curricular Activities.

Co-curricular Activities are defined as the activities that enable to supplement and complement the curricular or main syllabi activities. These are the very important part and parcel of educational institution to develop the students' personality as well as to strengthen the classroom learning.

These activities are organized after the school hours, so known extra-curricular activities. Co-curricular Activities have wide horizon to cater to the Cultural, Social, Aesthetic Development of the Child.

FACILITIES



CLASS ROOM : The class rooms are spacious airy and naturally lighted. The use of modern teaching aids as OHPs and LCDs are used all the time along with the theorizing classes. So a study session is seldom a monotony, as the class rooms themselves are welcome grace.

SCIENCE LABORATORY : The School Provides Modern state of the Art Science Laboratory. It is well equipped with Ultra Modern Gadgets and Instruments and is very well maintained. Laboratory is the ideal place for the cultivation of a scientific mind that questions, delves divulges and infers.

MATHEMATICS LABORATORY : A Separate Laboratory for Mathematics is provided, so that students can develop their acumen to think and work logically even as they get deft with the handling of numerical, their usage, and various simple and complicated problems related to it. Books and aids assist the students to think deep, research and work out more systematically.

COMPUTER LABORATORY : This is a Technotronic age where in every individual has to be not only computer literate but also computer savvy. Each student sits at a system and works out individually under the able guidance of the instructors.

LIBRARY : School is a place to acquire knowledge and furnish one's spirituality and attune mental faculty, so books play the most important role in the student's life.

The Scholars and books are an integral part. For the school has a spacious, well lighted airy store house of books on all subjects that are part of the academics and even several other books ancillary to these. A fully computerized Library provides digital and audio visual facilities which greatly help to assimilate textural matters that they draw form.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT : (1) Guardians are requested to make their own conveyance arrangement as far as possible. (2) Bus Facility is available for limited number of students. (3) If Guardians do not want to avail the Transport Facility, after having availed it for some time, they must give two months prior notice or pay two months Transport charges. (4) Transport charges are payable for 12 months. (5) In case of any breakdown, parents will have to make their own transport arrangement till the vehicle is road worthy. (6) The school buses will Pick-up students form specified points only and will not provide door to door services. (7) The school will take utmost care to ensure safe travel, however, in the event of any accident, it will not be liable for any damages charges on account of injuries, fatal or otherwise, which may be sustained by the student while utilizing school transport. All expenses that may be incurred in the treatment of such injuries will be borne by the parents / guardians.



SPECIAL SUMMER CAMP

Playing with freedom is the birth right of child. Today the urbanization process is happening fast and open areas are rapidly vanishing. The deteriorating law and order creates problems not heard of in earlier days. The changing urban Scenario has deprived children of their legitimate right of playing with freedom and of enjoying the company of like minded children of their age group. They are left with no option except being confined to house and viewing television. This adversely affects physical and mental growth and social adjustment of a child.

The R.P.C.S. Organizes Summer Camp under **FUN-POINT** to Provide unique play activities for the kids within the age group of 2-12 Yr. the activities are performed under guidance for close monitoring by the school authorities.



PARENTS - TEACHERS MEETING : The School against organize monthly meetings of Parents/Teachers for the welfare of the children in the month. Attendance of at least one of the parents in such meeting is compulsory.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO GUARDIANS :

- Check the Haircut, Uniform and Punctuality of your ward in the morning.
- It is always advisable to write to the school about the problems of your ward or for seeking guidance. Your letters will be replied to after discussion with concerned Teachers. In case of Parents wanting discussion with more than one Teachers, a meeting will be arranged with the concerned Teachers.
- Check your ward's School Diary daily. Do sign the remarks if any and take necessary action.
- See that your ward carries Books/Exercise Books according to the Time Table for that day. No extra Books are allowed.
- Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in Studies, Co-curricular Activities and Sports.
- Plan further education of your wards beyond the school in good time so that they may be eligible to compete for the maximum number of institutions of higher education.
- Children should not bring Crackers, Colours, Toys, I-Pads, Mobile Phones etc. to the school. Bursting of Crackers and playing with colours is liable to lead to expulsion of a student from the school.
- Your ward should be instructed to be careful about his/her things. There should be a name tag on Coat and Sweaters any electronic gadgets or expensive articles should not be brought to school in case of violation of this rule the article will be confiscated. The school bears no responsibility for articles lost in school. In case of a loss, a letter giving details of the loss may be sent to the class teacher.
- If your ward is absent from school, he must make up all the work missed by him.
- If your ward is to leave the school campus during school hours, guardian should obtain a gate pass from the reception and get it signed from the Class Teacher, Bus/Supervision Teacher and Principal. This must be presented to the Guard at the time of leaving.





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
